Subject: Rescinding of Phase 2 Interim Flight and Duty Limitations and return to Phase 1 Standard Flight and Duty Limitations

Effective August 21, 2024, Phase 2 Interim Flight and Duty Limitations is rescinded (NMAC [M2024-09](#)). Standard Flight and Duty Limitations will be in effect and can be found at the link below. Please note that any time fatigue is of concern or noted, additional rest periods and days off may be requested and granted in accordance with agency policy. Aviation personnel should remain vigilant and monitor themselves and coworkers for fatigue and take a proactive approach to mitigation.
